Essential Elements of Mass Fatality Management, (EM 160) is an awareness-level course designed to assist healthcare facilities in planning for the management of mass fatality incidents. It provides staff with an overview of a mass fatality incident and core elements of planning and response management through the Incident Command Structure.

- ▼ Define the concept of mass fatality
- ▼ Describe the core elements of mass fatality management plans
- ▼ Explain the Incident Command System and the integration of the Mass Fatality Branch
- ▼ Examine the impact of mass fatality events on healthcare facilities
